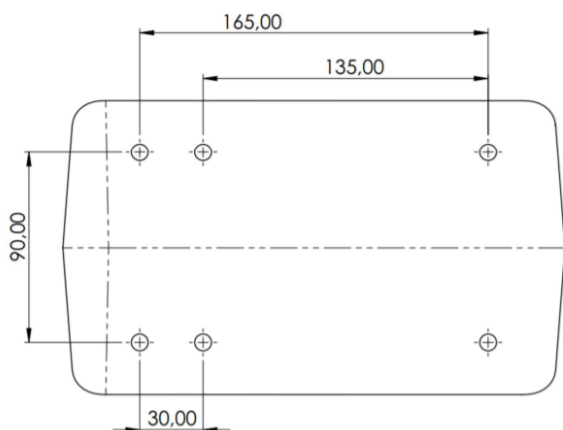

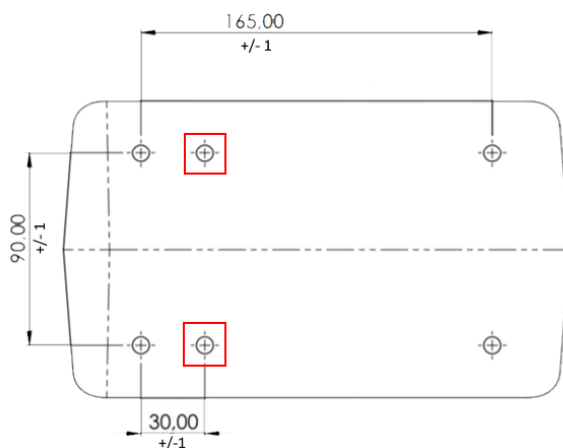

A helmet to the minimum standard EN1385 or EN1077 or equivalent with at least 300 square centimeters of the exterior surface in a high visibility colour shall be worn at all times when afloat, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment.

Amend to read:

C.3.2(c)

A helmet to the minimum standard EN1385 or EN1077 or equivalent with a total area of at least 300 square centimetres of the exterior surface in a high visibility colour not divided in more than 4 parts shall be worn at all times when afloat, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. If prescribed by the Notice of Race, the crew shall display nationality flags on the helmet as instructed by the Notice of Race.
