



# NOTICE OF RACE

## SNIPE CLASS INTERNATIONAL RACING ASSOCIATION 2021 Women`s Snipe World Championship ROY YAMAGUCHI TROPHY October 06<sup>th</sup> thru 09<sup>th</sup>, 2021

### ORGANIZING AUTHORITY:

Yacht Club Paulista and Associação Brasileira da Classe Snipe,  
in cooperation with the Snipe Class International Racing Association.

### 1. RULES:

The regatta will be governed by:

- 1.1 The rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 The SCIRA Rules of Conduct for Conducting National and International Championship Regattas (RoC) available at [https://www.snipe.org/images/2021/SCIRA\\_2021\\_Rules\\_of\\_Conduct\\_final.pdf](https://www.snipe.org/images/2021/SCIRA_2021_Rules_of_Conduct_final.pdf)
- 1.3 The Deed of Gift, available at <http://www.snipe.org/class/deeds-of-gift>.
- 1.4 The RRS as modified by the Rules for Conducting National and International Championship Regattas (RoC) as specified in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.5 The following National Prescription will apply:  
RRS 67 - CBVela prescribes that the organizing authority will appoint those responsible for the repair of damage.
- 1.6 The decision of the Jury will be final in accordance with RRS 70.5.
- 1.7 RRS Appendix T will apply.
- 1.8 If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.

### 2. ADVERTISING:

- 2.1 Advertising is permitted in accordance with WS Regulation 20.
- 2.2 Boats may be requested to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

### 3. ENTRY AND ELIGIBILITY:

- 3.1 This regatta is open to SCIRA registered boats and female Class Member skippers and crews who are in good standing with SCIRA for the current year, subject to any Deed of Gift restrictions.
- 3.2 No skipper or crew shall be eligible to enter any Class championship race unless:
  - they possess and present a current Class Membership Card, or
  - SCIRA-issued equivalent, or
  - shows as a current member in the SCIRA Official Online Database.
- 3.3 Bow numbers are assigned at registration and it shall be each competitor's sole responsibility to properly affix them in conformance with the instructions and to properly maintain them.

The Entry fee will include: Opening Ceremonies Cocktail, Mid-regatta Dinner, Awards Party, Competitor's Kit.

Coach/team support boats are required to pay a USD 60 fee. This includes entry to social events for 1 person. Coaches/on-water team support shall register online at <https://2021womens.snipeworlds.org>

Mid-regatta dinner extra tickets available at the venue: USD 20 (includes salad, pasta, dessert, soft drinks).

Musical Sunset By the Lake: free entrance (pay what you consume at Snack Bar).

Registered teams who notify either of the regatta co-chairs via email no later than midnight of September 4th, 2021 of their intent to withdraw, their registration are eligible for an 80% refund.

### 5.1 Registration:

Registration opens June 8<sup>th</sup>, until July 20<sup>th</sup> early bird fees apply; from July 21<sup>st</sup> until September 7<sup>th</sup> regular fees apply; from September 8<sup>th</sup> until September 30<sup>th</sup> late fees will be charged.

### 5.2 Measurement: from October 4<sup>th</sup> to October 6<sup>th</sup>.

### 5.3 Schedule of Races: from October 6<sup>th</sup> to October 9<sup>th</sup>.

### 5.4 Three (03) races need to be completed to constitute the regatta.

### 5.5 Eight (08) races are scheduled.

### 5.6 No races to be started if wind average velocity, measured from the RC signal boat at the starting line, exceeds 18 knots prior to preparatory signal.

## 6. MEASUREMENT:

6.1 All boats shall be presented for inspection with the full equipment, including sails and personal flotation devices during the scheduled measurement. Boats and equipment shall be presented in a dry, clean and salt-free condition. The Race Committee may extend the measurement time.

6.2 Measurement will take place at the measuring tent in front of Boat House 2.

6.3 All boats shall produce a valid measurement certificate and a MDS on file with the SCIRA office and are subject to measurement at any time at the reasonable discretion of the Class or Race Committee.

6.4 All boats are required to have a current Class decal properly displayed.

6.5 In case of charter boats, both hull and sail number must have paid the SCIRA decal.

## 7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

The Sailing Instructions will be available on the official website <https://2021womens.snipeworlds.org>

## 8. VENUE:

Races will be sailed at Race Course 2 of the Represa Guarapiranga, São Paulo, Brasil.



## **9. COURSES:**

The courses to be sailed are the Class approved courses as published in the SCIRA Rulebook or website.

## **10. SCORING:**

- 10.1 The Low Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A, will apply.
- 10.2 If six or more races are completed, the worst race shall be excluded.

## **11. SUPPORT BOATS:**

Support boats shall register, within the limits specified in 5.1 above, with the Organizing Committee that will assign an identification to be shown visible on the boat throughout the event.

## **12. RADIO COMMUNICATION:**

- 12.1 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats.
- 12.2 This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

## **13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## **14. PRIZES:**

- 14.1 Prizes will be awarded to the top five (5) teams, skippers and crews.
- 14.2 The Roy Yamaguchi Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the winning skipper and her crew.
- 14.3 Prizes will be awarded to the top three (3) junior teams, skippers and crews.
- 14.4 The Carmen Diaz Trophy shall be presented to the winning team with both skipper and crew under twenty two (22) years. In the event that there is no team with both the skipper and crew under 22, the highest placing skipper under 22 shall be eligible.

## **15. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS:**

By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to SCIRA, the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recording, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

## **16. QUALIFICATION FOR SUBSEQUENT EVENT:**

The 2021 Women's Worlds Champion will qualify for the 2022 Snipe World Championship in Japan.
