Who was Jorge Zarif?

Jorge Zarif, known as Guga or Zarif, was a dear person for everyone and was one of the greats of Brazilian Sailing, winning several titles in the Laser, Finn and Star Ocean classes.

But it was in the Finn that his career as a sailor had great importance because he represented Brazil in two Olympic Games - Los Angeles 1984 and Seoul 1988 - and several World Championships.

He was a thorough sailor. As well as being a great sailor of monotypes classes, he also had a great sailor training, because since a child he participated on his father's boat in the ocean sailing regattas, which were once held in the open sea and had long duration.
